Far-Reaching Experience

Here are just a few of the many ways LSInc has successfully met customers' requirements.

- Managed emergency shipments to Yemen (both material and personnel) required to stabilize the USS Cole after terrorist attack.
- Orchestrated two Special Assignment Airlift Missions in response to urgent fleet requirements: a classified propeller to SSN 770 Tucson in three days and a sonar dome and accessory equipment to DDG 59 Russell in two days.
- Expedited the shipment of CVN Class 77 propellers from Pascagoula MS to Williamsburg, VA for CVN 73 George Washington, resulting in over \$700,000 in maintenance cost savings.
- Aided search and rescue efforts, such as the TWA 800 crash off Long Island, the Japanese fishing boat EHIME MARU and the crash of John Kennedy's plane near Martha's Vineyard.
- Helped complete the emergency transport of a Trident submarine propeller from Bangor, WA to the Navy Trident facility in Kings Bay, GA in less than seven days. Shipments of this size and complexity normally take three weeks or more.
